Vocabulary:

Positional

concepts (prepositions)

Level 1: in/out, on/off,
inside/outside, up/down-
receptively (understanding)
and expressively in words,
phrases, and sentences

Grammar/Syntax:

The pronoun "she" (vs. her)
including auditory
discrimination (hearing the
difference), and production
of the correct form in
phrases and sentences (e.g.
"her runs in the park" vs.
"she runs in the park")

Speech Sound/Articulation:

/K/ and /G/ or the phonological process of "fronting" (when children produce /T/ and /D/ for /K/ and /G/. (e.g. "tall" for "call", "bite" for "bike," or "doe" for "go."))

- minimal pairs & auditory discrimination (e.g. "point to the one I say. key.") to help the child hear the difference.
 - instruction in how to produce the sound using lollipops/spoons/tongue depressors to hold the tongue tip down, forcing the back of the tongue up
- production of /K/ and /G/ in the initial, medial, and final positions of words, phrases, and sentences
